CONSTRUCTION WORKS & CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT

Construction works and Campus Development are actively progressing in various Campuses of the University. These works are mainly entrusted with CPWD and Nirmithi Kendra. The details of construction works and its present status are attached as a seperate file.

Computerisation of University Branches

Computerisation activities are ongoing in the Examination Branch of the University. The project of Computerisation with an estimated cost of Rs. 15,15,000/- was entrusted with C-DIT, Thiruvananthapuram.

The objective of the project is to develop a computerised network in the Examination Section (at present PG, B.Tech and other professional courses) so as to automate the activities related to tabulation process, preparation of mark lists, maintaining various registers etc.

After conducting the System Study, computers and other accessory hardwares had been acquired through C-DIT and the application software developed by C-DIT exclusively for the University has been tested for its applicability.

Phase-I of the project will be completed after making necessary modifications in the infrastructure including civil engineering and electrical engineering works.

Official Website of the University

Considering the relevance and use of Internet and its most popular service- the world wide web - in the academic activities, Kannur University launched its website www.kannuruniversity.ac.in in the year 2004. The website now redesigned with informative and resource rich web pages, catering to the general information needs of student community as well as the teachers and general public.

Chairs and Endowments

Barrister M.K. Nambyar Chair in Constitutional and Administrative Law was instituted in the School of Legal Studies of the University at Thalassery Campus, Palayad. Shri. K.K. Venugopal, Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India donated Rs. 15 lakh for this purpose. The Chair was instituted in honour of Barrister M.K. Nambyar, an eminent constitutional lawyer who hailed from Malabar Region.

The main objective of the Chair includes:

- *Organising seminars, workshops etc.
- *Supporting reserach in Constitutional and Administrative Law
- *Instituting awards and prizes to meritorious students
- *To involve professionals and other dignitaries associated with law in the programme to share their knowledge and experties with academic community.

Former Supreme Court Judge, Justice Shri. K.T. Thomas has been appointed as the Honorary Professor of the Chair for the academic year 2006-07.

Inaugural function of the Chair was held on 29th October 2005 at Mangattuparamba Campus. The chair was formally inaugurated by His Excellency R.L. Bhatia, the Governor of Kerala along with the inauguration of decennial celebrations.

Programmes of the Chair conducted at school of Legal studies, Thalassery Campus, where the chair had been constituted during the year 2006 is as follows.

The second lecture of the chair was held on 4th April 2006. Justice Shri.K.T.Thomas, the Honorary Professor of the chair delivered his 2nd & 3rd lecture on “Parliamentary privileges and freedom of press” and Justice Shri. Bhaskaran Nambiar, Former Upalokayuktha delivered a lecture on “ Court and Constitution”. The function held on 5th August 2006, Justice Shri. K.T.Thomas and Justice Shri. Basanth, Hon’ble Judge, High Court of Kerala delivered a lecture. Shri.K.K Venugopal, Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi delivered a lecture on “My fifty years at the Bar” in the function held at 6th October 2006. Justice Shri. K.T.Thomas also delivered a lecture in the functions held at 6th October 2006 and 7th December 2006.

Kannur University Research Project on Development of Malabar.

Kannur University Research Project on Development of Malabar was launched with a view to encourage individual initiative in research. The University provides financial assistance for conducting research projects in subject areas related to North Malabar region. The following subject areas were identified as priority areas under the project.

1. Traditional industries
2. Agriculture and forestry
3. Waste Management
4. Water procurement
5. Sea-Coast Management
6. Eco-tourism
7. Folklore
8. Ethnic knowledge on medical plants and traditional system of medicine.

The project was formally launched at a function held at the Mangattuparamba Campus on 1st December 2003.

Distance Education Programmes

The School of Distance Education was established in the University in the year 2002 with B.Com.Course. It was formally inaugurated on January 28, 2004. At present it offers Nine UG courses four PG courses and one certificate course. ‘Additional optional Co-operation’ for B.Com. Degree holders of this university.

The SDE has started overseas centres in Dubai, Abudhabi, Doha and Muscut. The SDE has been registered with Distance Education Council and had received an amount of Rs.20 Lakhs from DEC as Development grants for the financial years 2003-04, 04-05 and 2006-07.

UGC Special Cell for SC/ST

The UGC Special Cell for SC/ST was established in the University in January 2005. This setup was in accordance with the X plan guide lines of UGC and it ensures effective implementation of reservation policy for SC/STs in the University and Colleges in respect of admissions, appointments to teaching and non-teaching positions etc.

Senate Election.

Detailed Schedule regarding election to senate of Kannur University was published, as per item (i),(iii)(iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (viii), (ix),(x), (xi), (xii), and (xiii) under 'Elected members' of section 19 of Kannur University Act 1996 in the Kerala Gazettee (Extra ordinary) under Reg. No. KL/TV/(N)/12/2003-2005, Vol XLIX No. 2639 dated 17-12-2004.

Budget 2006-07

The University Budget for the financial year 2006-07 (as provided under section 51 of the Kannur University Act 1996 and Section 16 of the Kannur University (Amendment) Act 2001) was approved by the Chancellor, Which anticipate a total receipt of Rs.4788.06 Lakhs and an expenditure of Rs.4909.47 Lakhs.

Central Assistance Under U.G.C. Central Development Grant During 10th Plan

Vide UGC Memorandum No. F9-10/94(CPP-1) dated 03.02.2004 Kannur University has been declared eligible to receive Central Assistance under 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956.

In pursuance of this, the UGC has sanctioned a grant of Rs. 4,61,20,000/- under X Plan Development Assistance Scheme. The X plan period commenced from 1st April 2002 and would be ending on 31st March 2007.

UGC has released a total amount of Rs.3,68,96,000/- against the Plan allocation of Rs. 4,61,20,000/- being the 1st and 2nd instalment of grant under its X Plan Development Assistance. The amount has been allocated for the purpose of construction of buildings & Campus Development, appointment of teaching staff, purchase of Books & Journals and Equipment required for the Teaching Departments & University Central Library. Besides two computer labs are being established costing Rs 20 lakhs each at Payyanur and Palayad Campuses. In addition to this UGC has sanctioned an amount of Rs 1 crore for the construction of Seminar Complex under the scheme of special development grant for young Universities and Rs. 25 lakhs for the construction of Women's Hostel at Palayad Campus under special scheme. A proposal for establishing a new Computer centre in the University is submitted to UGC for approval. UGC has also sanctioned an amount of Rs. 50,000/- for establishing a Population Education Resource Centre and an amount of Rs. 1 lakh being non recurring grant towards promotion of Yoga in Universities. Under unassigned Grant scheme, U.G.C. sanctioned an amount of Rs 4 lakhs to Kannur University.

UNIVERSITY CENTRAL LIBRARY & CAMPUS LIBRARIES

Kannur University Central Library was established in 1998. It is located at Kannur Town and has been serving various sections of the user community in the University viz, faculty, students, staff, graduates and also students belonging to other University area. There is also facility of temporary membership to others for utilizing the library services. The library is kept open from 8 am to 8 pm on all working days and from 9 am to 2 pm on second Saturdays and Sundays. It is also a recognised research Centre of the University in the subjects of History, Sanskrit, Statistics, Philosophy, English, Sociology, Economics, Malayalam, Urdu and Music.

The central library has a total collection of 17,060 books and 165 subscribed periodicals. The library is partially computerised using the library software ‘SOUL’ developed by the INFLIBNET, Ahmedabad, an inter University Centre of UGC.

Since most of the teaching departments are located in Thalassery campus, a centralised Campus Library has been established in Thalassery Campus also, in support of the academic activities. This campus library has a total collection of 21,919 books and 58 subscribed periodicals catering to the needs of students and teachers of the various teaching departments in the campus.
