Regulations for Afzal-ul-Ulama Preliminary programme Under Faculty of Language & Literature

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 The regulations framed herein shall apply to Afzal-ul-Ulama Preliminary programme under the faculties of languages and literature conducted in the affiliated colleges.
- 1.2 These regulations shall come into effect from 2009 admission.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Candidate for Afzal-ul-Ulama Preliminary examination shall be required to be eligible for higher studies in SSLC, or an examination equivalent thereto.
- 2.2 The criteria for selection of students to the course and regulations regarding the reservation of seats shall be as per rules framed by the Government/University from time to time.

3. DURATION

The duration of the course shall be two years.

4. COURSE OF STUDY

- 4.1 The course shall comprise the study of the following subjects:

Part I – Arabic
Part II – English
Part III – Optional subjects

- 4.2 No candidate shall be declared eligible for Afzal-ul-Ulama Preliminary certificate unless he has completed the course of studies prescribed and passed the examination in all the subjects under the three parts of the examination, viz, Part I Arabic, Part II English, Part III Optional Subjects.

4.3 Pass Minimum

Candidate for Afzal-ul-Ulama Preliminary shall be declared to have passed the examination in

- a. Part I – Arabic – if he obtains not less than 40% of aggregate marks of the three papers comprised in that part.
- b. Part II – English – if he obtains not less than 40% of the aggregate marks of the two papers comprised in that part.
- ✓ c. Part III – Optional Subjects – if he obtains not less than 40% of the aggregate marks in the papers of the Part III subjects to a minimum of 30% for each paper.

✓ A candidate securing 40% of marks in Part III as a whole but failing to qualify for a pass
