PROSPECTUS

Single Application form will do for applying at the three campuses. Mark the campuses in the order of preference. Candidates are advised to go through the instructions carefully before filling up the application form. Incomplete and defective applications will summarily be rejected.

Instructions to Candidates:

- 1. General Information:** The Bachelor Education (B. Ed.) course of Kannur University has been designed to extend the benefit of the Teacher Training to
 - a) Highly qualified candidates who pass out of the Universities every year.
 - b) Qualified regular teachers in service of Government/Aided Schools of the Kerala State who have practical difficulty in getting admission to regular colleges of the Teacher Education.
- 2. Strength of Students:** 100 students each at Kannur, Kasaragod and Mananthavady Campuses.
- 3. Course Content:** The course will follow the general rules prescribed for the B.Ed course by the University with respect to academic standards for admission, course of study, scheme of examination, instructional hours and the practice teaching requirements. The course will normally be for a period of one year.
- 4. Attendance:-** Every candidates shall have a minimum of 80% attendance including practice teaching session in order to make him/her eligible to appear for the University examination.

7. Eligibility for admission

Candidates seeking admission to the B.Ed. course should have passed B.A./B.Sc/M.Com Degree examination (under the 10+2+3 pattern) with one main subject and two subsidiary subjects from this University or any other University recognized by this University as equivalent thereto.

Double or triple main candidates of other Universities will be considered for admission only if they furnish the copies of the equivalency & eligibility certificate from Kannur University stating that the qualifying examination is recognized for seeking admission to B.Ed Degree course in a particular optional subject. Equal weightage is given to Single main, Double main and Triple main Degree holders.

The minimum requirement of marks for admission to B. Ed. Course is 45 % (No rounding off the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted) in Bachelor's Degree [Science / Arts Subjects] in aggregate (i.e. for Part I + II + III) or M Com.

Relaxation in Marks

Candidates belonging to SC/ST, natives of Lakshadweep need secure a pass in the Degree Examination. The candidates belonging to OBC will be given a relaxation of 3% and the candidates belonging to OEC will be given a relaxation of 5% from the prescribed minimum marks.

Eligibility for different optional subjects

Languages

- Arabic** : BA Degree with Arabic Language and Literature with 45% marks in aggregate or BA/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part II Arabic and not less than 50% of marks for Master's Degree in Arabic Language and Literature.
- English**: BA Degree with English language and Literature/Functional English/B.A Communicative English with 45% marks or BA/B.Sc. with 50% of marks for Part I English and not less than 50% marks in Master's Degree in English Language and Literature.
- Hindi** : BA Degree with Hindi Language and Literature with 45% marks in aggregate or BA/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part II Hindi and not less than 50% of marks for Master's Degree in Hindi Language and Literature.
- Kannada**: BA Degree with Kannada Language and Literature with 45% marks in aggregate or BA/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part II Kannada and not less than 50% of marks for Master's Degree in Kannada Language and Literature.

- e) **Malayalam:** BA Degree with Malayalam language and literature with 45% marks in aggregate or BA/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part II Malayalam and not less than 50% of marks for Master's Degree in Malayalam language and literature.
- f) **Sanskrit :** BA Degree with Sanskrit Language and Literature with 45% marks in aggregate or BA/B.Sc with 50% of marks for Part II Sanskrit and not less than 50% of marks for Master's Degree in Sanskrit Language and Literature.

Note: Candidates applying for the course under the language stream with a Bachelor's Degree in the subject concerned will be ranked first in that particular stream. Candidates applying for the course under any language stream based on Part I/Part II at under graduate level and having PG Degree in the same subject as in Part I/Part II will be ranked only after that.

Other Optionals

- a) **Mathematics:** B.Sc. Degree with Mathematics/Statistics/Applied Statistics as main, with 45% marks in aggregate. Candidates with Statistics/Applied Statistics should have studied Mathematics as one of the subjects.
- b) **Physical Science:** B.Sc. Degree with Physics/Chemistry/Polymer Chemistry/B.Sc. Geology/B.Sc. Petrochemicals/ B.Sc. Bio-Chemistry/ B.Sc. Industrial Chemistry main with 45% marks in aggregate.
- c) **Natural Science:** B.Sc. Degree with Botany /Zoology / Bio –Chemistry/ B.Sc. Plant Science/ Home Science (with Zoology or Botany as subsidiary) Aquaculture (With Biochemistry and Zoology as Subsidiaries)/Biotechnology/Microbiology with 45% marks in aggregate.
- d) **Social Science :** B.A. Degree with History /Arabic and Islamic History main with 45% marks in aggregate or B.A. Degree with Geography/Politics/Economics/Sociology /Psychology/Philosophy/West Asian Studies under part III and with 45% marks in aggregate.
- e) **Commerce :** M.Com. degree with 45% marks in aggregate .Such candidates are not eligible to any other B.Ed Course.

8. Selection Criteria:

- a) Selection is based on the marks obtained by the applicant in the Degree Examination for Part III or Part I or Part II as the case may be. A reduction of one point will be made in the index mark for every repeated chance.
- b) Special weightage will be given to post graduate, in the same subject concerned as shown below:

M.A./ M.Sc	I st Class	5 Points
- do-	II nd Class	3 Points
- do-	III rd Class	2 Points

Weightage will be given to candidates who have taken Degree from Kannur University. A weightage of five index points to the natives of Kannur University jurisdiction (ie. Kannur, Kasaragod Revenue Districts and Mananthavady Taluk of Wayanad Revenue District) for admission to B.Ed. course in all institutions maintained by or affiliated to the University on production of Nativity Certificate issued by the Competent Revenue Authority.

- c) Weightage will be given to Teachers in Government/Aided School service. Total approved service of applicants will be considered in ranking. Approved Service means full time teaching experience in Government/Aided Schools duly certified by the controlling officer that is Head of the School and countersigned by the concerned A.E.O/D.E.O.
- d) 10% of seats are reserved for Teachers in service of Kerala. Teachers having a minimum of 3 years experience with relaxation of 2 years to T.T.C holders, 1 year to L.T.T.C/Diploma in Teaching and one year to Diploma in Pre-Primary Education as per rules as on the date of notification alone are eligible to apply for selection under Teacher's quota. Those who are eligible to get study leave for the duration of the entire course from the authority concerned alone need apply and in case they are selected for the course, they should produce a certificate from the Head of Schools concerned, that they have applied for eligible leave for the duration of the course before being admitted.
- e) Those who have undergone NCC Training with minimum 75% attendance as stipulated in GO 673/04/HEDN, dated 15-04-1994 will be given an additional 5 marks. This will be added to the aggregate marks obtained by the candidate.
- f) In the case of applicants with double main and triple main subjects, admission will be based on the total of all main subjects, and weightage will be given only on the subject which the applicant applies as optional.
- g) Ezhava/Thiyya/Billava/Muslim/O.B.H/SIUC/LC applicants are eligible for consideration for reservation of seats as per the Government rules in this regard.
- 8. Accommodation:** In view of the special nature of the course and the difficulty in arranging accommodation in the campus, the University does not undertake the responsibility to provide residential accommodation to the students of B.Ed course.

9. Fees:

- a) **Application and Registration Fee:** An amount of Rs.400/- (Rupees Four Hundred only) should be paid by way of chalan or Current A/C pay in slip (SBT) for Kannur University. The chalan/ pay in slip in original should be attached to the filled in application.
- b) **Course fee :** An amount of Rs.19,000/-(Rupees Nineteen thousand only) should be paid by way of chalan/ Current A/C pay in slip (SBT) for Kannur University at the time of admission.

Demand Drafts will be accepted only from candidates residing outside Kerala.Demand Drafts shall be drawn in favour of the Finance Officer,Kannur University payable at SBT Kannur University Campus Branch. DDs drawn from banks other than SBT should be payable at Kannur

Note : Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC are exempted from paying the course fee on admission. However they will be required to pay the fees as a whole or to the extent to which reimbursement from Government is not made.

10. Attested Certificates / Documents to be submitted along with the application : (Those should be produced in original at the time of admission.)

- Secondary School Leaving Certificate
- Qualifying Degree/ PG certificate and of higher qualifications, if any.
- Mark Lists of qualifying Degree Examination.
- Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate.

- e) Nativity, Income and Community Certificate for those who claim weightage or reservation benefit.
- f) Experience Certificate in Form IV of KER for claiming admission under Teacher's quota and for giving weightage for teaching experience. These certificates should be signed by the Head of School and countersigned by AEO/DEO.
- g) Equivalency & eligibility certificate from the university in the case of double or triple main candidates
- h) Any other certificates from the competent authorities for the claim of admission under any specific quota that is Sports/NCC/Person With Disability/ Linguistic Minority/Ex-Servicemen etc. if applicable.
- i) The original Chalan/Demand Draft/Pay in slip for **Rs.400-**

If any of these certificates is not produced, the Course Director has the right to summarily reject the claim for admission.

11. The list of provisionally selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the Departments of Teacher Education. The provisionally selected candidates will be required to appear for an interview at the Department. They are expected to pay the course fee of Rs.19,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Thousand only) and submit all the original documents if they are finally selected. The Department will not be responsible for non-receipt of communications due to postal delay. Applicants are required to verify the date of interview which will be published on the notice board at all the three departments. Candidates who do not report in time will forfeit all claim for admission.
12. **Reservation of Seats:** There shall be reservation of seats as per the norms and rules of the University/Government, laid down in this regard and adopted by the Kannur University from time to time. One seat is reserved under Sports Quota at each centre.
13. The University reserves the right to deny admission to any selected candidates if he/she is found to be unsuitable for teaching profession.
14. **Special Instructions:**
 - a. Only one application along with original Chalan/DD is to be submitted for admission at the three departments. Application Form can be downloaded from the university website and the filled in application should be submitted to the Course Director (B.Ed), Department of Teacher Education, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Dharmasala, Kannur University Campus P.O., Kannur - 670567.
 - b. Candidates applying for admission under **Sports Quota** should submit a Photostat copy of his/her application, separately with the superscription "Sports Quota"
 - c. Each candidate is required to specify in the relevant columns of the application form the code of the community and quota as noted below under which they wish to apply.
