PROSPECTUS

M.Ed. (Regular) Two Semester Course

1. Course of Study:

Master of Education (Regular) Comprising of Two Semesters.

2. Duration of the Course:

210 Working days (Two semester of 105 days each).

3. Number of Seats:

The total number of intake will be 25.

4. Reservation:

Reservation rules specifically applicable for SC/ST/OBC/OEC and Physically Handicapped candidates for admission to various courses of studies in the University Teaching Departments will be applicable for M. Ed. (Regular) course also.

5. Eligibility for Admission:

B. Ed. Degree of the Kannur University or a B. Ed. Degree recognized by Kannur University as equivalent thereto with not less than 55% marks. Relaxation in marks will be given to SEBC/OBC/OEC and SC/ST candidates as per the University Admission Rules for Master's Degree Course.

6. Application Procedure:

The completed application form shall accompany an Entrance Examination fee of Rs. 250/- (Rs. 350 with applications downloaded from the Kannur University Website) as DD obtained from any branch of SBT drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, Kannur University payable at SBT, Kannur University Campus Branch and with attested copies of relevant documents should reach the Director, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Kannur University, Kannur University Campus P.O., PIN – 670 567 on or before the last date notified by the University. Late and incomplete applications will summarily be rejected.

7. Selection:

The selection shall be from the rank list prepared on the basis of the following criteria:

The M. Ed. Entrance Examination will be of 100 marks for 1 ½ hours duration consists of objective type of questions. The question paper will be based on the syllabus of the General Papers at the B. Ed. Level.

8. Fee:

Selected candidates should remit Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) towards tuition fee and other fees fixed by University by way of DD drawn in favour of The Finance Officer, Kannur University. (SC/ST candidates are exempted from the payment of tuition fee)

9. Attendance:

80% of attendance is compulsory for each semester failing which the candidate shall not be permitted to appear for the examination.

10. Other details:

The list of selected candidates will be displayed on the Notice Board of the School of Pedagogical Sciences at Dharmasala Campus. The selected candidates are to appear for an interview at the School of Pedagogical Sciences, wherein the original of their certificates and other documents will be verified. Candidates selected are to remit the fees and submit all the original documents at the time of admission. Candidates who have not been selected will not be intimated.

The school of Pedagogical Sciences will not be responsible for non-receipt of communication due to postal delay. Candidates are requested to verify the date of interview which will be published through press release and also on the Notice Board of the School of Pedagogical Sciences. Candidates who report after the prescribed time and date of interview will forfeit all claims for admission.

The Director, School of Pedagogical Sciences, reserves all the rights to reject any application or deny admission to any selected candidate if he/she is found to be unsuitable for the course.

11. Nature of the Course:

The course consists of two parts, Part I and Part II.

Part I – Theory Papers (A & B)

A. Core papers

Paper I – Philosophical & Sociological Foundations of Education.

Paper II – Methodology of Educational Research and Educational Statistics.

Paper III – Advanced Educational Psychology.

B. Optional papers – (Two groups)

(All electives may not be offered in a particular year)

Part II – Dissertation:

Each candidate has to carry out an investigation under the supervision of a member of faculty of the school. Four copies of the dissertation should be submitted to the Director, School of Pedagogical Sciences, by the end of the second semester.

Viva-voce

A Viva-voce Examination based on the dissertation of each candidate shall be held after the theory examination of second semester.

12. Scheme of Examination:

The University Examination will be conducted at the end of each semester. Examination in Part I A will be held at the end of the first semester and in Part I B at the end of the second semester. There will be an internal assessment of 20 marks each to all the five theory papers of the two semesters. The candidate has to submit the dissertation one week prior to the last working day of the second semester. The dissertation shall carry 150 marks and the Viva-voce Examination based on research methodology and dissertation shall carry 25 marks. In addition to these, each student has to submit a project report on field-based experiences related to supervision and evaluation of practice teaching and other school experiences of B. Ed. Programme which carries 25 marks.

A candidate shall be declared as having passed the M. Ed. Degree examination in second class if he/she obtains a minimum of 50% marks in each paper and 50% as aggregate of two semesters and who secures 60% marks and above on the aggregate of two semesters shall be placed in the first class. This will also be applicable to the results of candidates availing more than one chance. If a candidate obtains less than 50% marks for the dissertation, he/she may be permitted to take the written examination and fulfill the thesis requirements separately but not more than three chances shall be given for the completion of the examination.

A candidate fails in the first semester examination may be permitted to continue for the second semester. But he/she can appear for the first semester in the next or the subsequent academic period only. If a candidate failed in the second semester, he/she can appear for the second semester in the next or subsequent academic year. A candidate can appear for the Viva-voce at the end of the second semester examination even if he/she has to complete the first semester examination.

An M. Ed. Degree holder may be permitted to improve his/her marks by appearing only for the written examination within the next two academic periods. For improvement of marks, only one chance shall be given and the candidate shall appear for both first and second semester and be in the same academic year. In such cases the marks for dissertation, Viva-voce and Internal assessment will be the same and will be carried over to the appearance for improvement.
