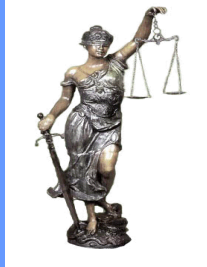

PROSPECTUS FOR THE FIVE YEAR B.A., LL.B.; LL.M. (CONSTITUTIONAL & ADMINISTRATIVE LAW) AND POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN HUMAN RIGHTS LAW COURSES

The Kannur University and its Law Department:

ADMISSION RULES OF B.A., LL.B. (5 Year) Course

Number of seats

The maximum number of seats for this course is Forty (40).

Eligibility for admission

In order to get admission to the course, the student shall pass the senior secondary school (+2) course or equivalent with not less than fifty percent of marks. Provided, the course shall be recognized by the Kannur University. Provided further that applicants who have obtained + 2 Higher Secondary pass Certificate after

prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission in the Integrated Five Years course. However, the applicants who have obtained 10 + 2 through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission.

Age

The maximum age for admission to the course is below twenty years as on 1st June of every academic year.

Admission process

The manner of admission shall be on the basis of entrance test conducted by the University or by the School as the case may be and a rank list shall be published on the basis of the average marks obtained by the candidate in the entrance examination and the marks he/she obtained in the +2 course. An admission committee shall be constituted for admission and the candidates shall be interviewed by the committee before granting admission. The reservation rules shall be followed before finalizing the admission and for that the rules provided by the University shall be followed.

The filled in Application form downloaded from the University website shall be submitted to the Head, School of Legal Studies

Manner of entrance test

The entrance test shall be of two hours duration carrying 100 (Hundred) marks. The entrance test is intended to test the general knowledge, logical reasoning, legal aptitude, English language skills etc of the candidate.

Fees

The fee fixed by the University shall be remitted by the student in each semester as notified by the Department.

ADMISSION RULES OF POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN HUMAN RIGHTS LAW

Number of seats

The maximum number of seats for this course is Fifty (50).

Eligibility for admission

Target Group is MBA/Engg Courses / LL.B Five Year or Three Year Degree Courses. Graduates in any discipline are also eligible for admission to this course.

Admission process

The filled in Application form downloaded from the University website shall be submitted to the Course Coordinator, School of Legal Studies. The manner of admission shall be on the basis of Interview conducted by the School and a rank list shall be published. An admission committee shall be constituted. The reservation rules are applicable and it shall be followed before finalizing the admission and for that the rules provided by the University shall be followed.

Fees

The fee fixed by the University shall be remitted by the student in each semester as notified by the Department.

Manner of conducting classes

The classes will be conducted on contact basis and evening which will be decided by the School and the University.

ADMISSION RULES OF LL.M.

Number of seats

The total number of seats for LL.M course is 12.

Eligibility for admission

A candidate who has passed the LL.B. examination of Kannur University or any other University recognized as equivalent and has secured not less than 50% of marks in aggregate are eligible

Admission process

Admission to the programme is on the basis of an entrance test and interview conducted by the Department or University. The maximum marks allotted to the entrance test and interview is 75 and 25. The ranking of the

candidate for the purpose of admission shall be made on the basis of the total marks he secures on adding the marks obtained in the entrance test and interview. The reservation rules of the University are applicable. The filled in Application form downloaded from the University website shall be submitted to the Head, School of Legal Studies
