**ORDER**

- 1.Enhancement of various fee rates of programmes conducted at the University teaching Departments/Centres were revised vide paper read (1) above, based on the directions received from the Government Vide paper read (2) above.
- 2.Non-enhancement of annual hike @ 5% on various fee rates, caused due to the issuance of the order by the government as per reference read (3) above on the backdrop of Covid-19 pandemic resulted in huge loss of revenue to the University for the last three years.
3. Meanwhile, fee for new programmes in the University teaching Departments /Centres started during this period were fixed and orders were issued as per the papers read (4) to (8) above.
4. As per paper read (9) above, the Syndicate considered the matter of enhancement of the fee rates of courses being conducted at the University Teaching Departments /Centers and resolved to entrust the Standing Committee on Finance to study the same and further resolved to authorise Vice-Chancellor to implement the recommendations.



5. Accordingly, the meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance held on 21.03.2023 submitted the following recommendations as per the paper read (10) above.

i) To increase the tuition fees and related fees of each program in the University Teaching Departments/Centres by 10%.

ii) To increase Admission fee of MA Malayalam program at par with the other programs after equalizing.

iii) To increase the fee by 5% for the programs commenced in the year 2021 and not to increase the fee for the programs commenced in the year 2022.

iv) Not to increase the Department Development Fund and Alumni Fee charged from the students at the time of admission.

6. The above recommendations were approved by the Vice Chancellor.

7. Subsequently, based on the above recommendation, Students Affiliation fee, Sports Affiliation Fee, University Union Fee and University Development Fee were also revised by the Office of the Director of Student Services vide the paper (11) above.

8. Further, The fee for the services rendered by Academic D section like Recognition Certificate, Equivalency Certificate, College Transfer Condonation and re-admission were enhanced to 10%, w.e.f 28.04.2023 as per the paper read (12) above, and the services rendered by Academic C section also enhanced by 10%, w.e.f 30.05.2023 as per paper read 13<sup>th</sup> above.

9. Hence, the revised fee structure for various programmes being conducted at the University Departments/Centers and various services rendered are fixed as detailed in the table below as approved by the Vice Chancellor.
