GUIDELINES FOR OPEN ELECTIVE COURSES

List of courses under the Programme Structure in University Departments in Kannur University consists of Core, Elective and Open Elective Courses. Open Elective Course means an elective course which is available for students of all programmes. Students of other Departments may opt these courses subject to fulfilling of eligibility criteria as laid down by the Department offering the course.

The following guidelines shall be followed regarding implementation of Open Courses in Teaching Departments of Kannur University.

- In the third semester all students shall compulsorily register for an Open Elective Course offered by other Departments or MOOC.
- Students shall have the option of choosing a course offered by any other department during other semesters provided they get the consent of the teacher engaging the course, Head of the Department offering the course and Head of the Department in which the student is studying.
- The list of Open Courses and MOOC Course offered by the Departments during the third semester with details including syllabus, mode of conduct, intended participants and prerequisites of the course should be uploaded to the Department website.
- Options are to be collected from students regarding their preferences for Open Elective Courses.
- Students shall consult their class mentors before opting for an Open Elective Course. The mentors should guide and assist the students in selecting the Open Courses/MOOC.
- The number of students that can be admitted to an Open Elective Course may be decided by the faculty engaging the Open Course in consultation with concerned Heads of Departments. The demand for the course, infrastructural and other facilities requirement may be considered while fixing the number of students.
- In case where the number of students opting for an Open Elective Course is more than number of students that can be admitted, students to be admitted to the course will be selected based on the marks(normalized) obtained in the I Semester. In the case of courses requiring certain skills like Music, aptitude tests may be conducted before registering students for such courses.
- Open courses may be conducted in online mode or hybrid mode depending on the course. In case of hybrid mode, the offline classes may be conducted on Saturdays/Holidays or without disturbing the regular classes.

• While preparing the Time table for Third Semester, all departments shall allot afternoons(starting 1.30 PM/2.00 PM) of Tuesday and Thursday for Open Elective Courses.
