- As per the paper read 1<sup>st</sup> above, modified norms and criteria for additional seats reserved under sports quota admission for UG/PG Programmes in the Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges and University Teaching Departments with effect from 2020 admission onwards, were issued.
- 2. Vide paper read 2<sup>nd</sup> above, the Principal, Govt. College Peringome has complained that the applicants who represented Kerala State in National Championships for Senior/Junior/Youth were not included under sports quota admission 2020-21.
- 3. As per the paper read 3<sup>rd</sup> above, the Senate moved a resolution that Sports Quota seat should be reserved for each course in University Teaching Departments.
- 4. The above matters were placed before the Sports Advisory Committee. As per the paper read 4th above, the Committee, vide resolution no. 1 & 2 has framed the modified norms/criteria for admission to seats reserved under Sports Quota for UG/PG programmes with effect from 2021 admission.
- 5. The Vice Chancellor has approved the above recommendations of the Sports Advisory Committee.
- 6. Hence orders are issued implementing modified norms/ criteria for admission to seats under Sports Quota for UG/PG programmes in the Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges and University Teaching Departments with effect from 2021 admission.
- 7. U.O. read (1) above stand modified to this extent.
- 8. The modified norms/criteria for admission to seats reserved under Sports Quota for UG/PG programmes in the Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges and University Teaching Departments from 2021 Admissions, are appended.
- 9. Orders are issued accordingly.

## Appendix to U.O. No. SWC/SWC/5962/2021 dated /07/2021

- 1.One sports Quota seat is reserved in all **Teaching Departments** over and above the sanctioned strength on the condition that the aspirants should qualify the entrance examination for the said Programme.
- 2.The Second Sports Quota additional seat in **PG courses in colleges** should be sanctioned only if it is meant for team formations/team building/ maintaining a team in a particular sports discipline or should be a SAI or Kerala State Sports Council hostel inmate/ trainee.
- 3. To include II Position and III Position as criteria for UG & PG Programmes
- 4. The last four years Sports Achievement for Sports Quota Admission in UG and PG Programmes should be considered for the academic year 2021-22 in view of covid pandemic
- 5. The revised criteria for award of marks for Sports achievements for Sports Quota admissions are given in the table below.
